The Village of Northfield through its Municipal Manager, developed a waterworks improvement project that included replacing eight thousand and five hundred (8500') of six-inch (6") and eight-inch (8") cast iron water main with a twelve-inch (12") ductile iron water main.

There were many challenges during the project as construction required keeping the old water main in service until the new one was installed. Munson Earth Moving had up to twenty-two (22) employees working in Northfield. The project started on the north end of Northfield Falls on May 16, 2008 and proceeded south. One of the benefits of the project was the widening of the shoulder on Winter Hill.

Munson Earth Moving finished the project a month and a half ahead of schedule.
